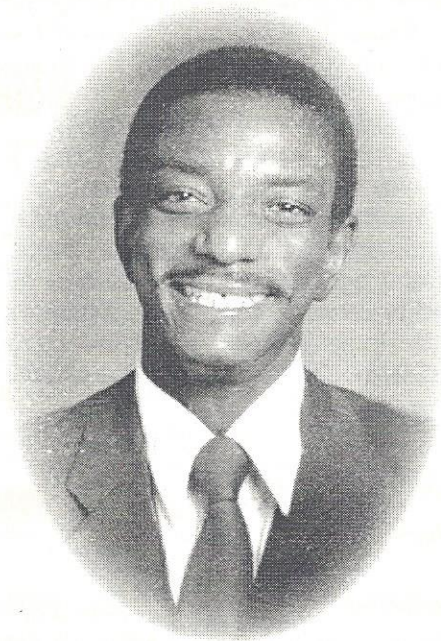

Obituary—

Lafayette Lovell Flack, age 51, was born April 8, 1950, in Chickasha, Oklahoma to John E. Flack and Carrie M. Bell. His friends referred to him simply as "Flack".

Lafayette's early childhood and elementary education began in Chickasha, Oklahoma where he attended Lincoln School through the 6th grade. He continued his elementary and secondary education when his family moved to Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri. Lafayette began his adult life by pursuing an interest in music. He created a band and performed in several local Missouri venues. In 1969, Lafayette returned to Chickasha, Oklahoma. He went to work at Stidham Horse Trailers where he developed welding skills. He utilized these skills throughout his professional career.

Lafayette married Debra Johnson in 1971 at Chickasha, Oklahoma and to this union two children were born, Tasha Rachel and Demia Rashun. Lafayette was stepfather to Russet Johnson, Didra Johnson and Aerial Johnson.

He later relocated to Oklahoma City where he continued working in the welding industry at Capitol Steel and Iron Company.

When he was called home, Lafayette was a member of the Church of The Living God.

Lafayette is preceded in death by his father, John E. Flack, his mother, Carrie M. Bell, and his brother, Reginald W. Bell.

Survivors include his daughters, Tasha R. Flack and Demia R. Flack, both of Sacramento, California; three sisters, Estella M. Moore and Marletta D. Bell, both of Chickasha, Oklahoma and Myra D. Bell, of St. Louis, Missouri; one brother, Wesley Bell, Jr., of Frisco, Texas; six grandchildren; seven nieces; four nephews, cousins, other relatives and a host of loving friends.
